Article 2 of the Constitution of the Republic of Uzbekistan that the state expresses the will of the people and serves its interests. Government agencies and officials are responsible to society and citizens. ” Therefore, there are responsible people for every citizen of our country. It will be recalled that the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan Shavkat Mirziyoyev in his

address to the OliyMajlis announced the development of a program to reduce poverty in the country.

In our country, a lot of work is being done to introduce foreign experience in reducing poverty in accordance with our national traditions. One of them is the Chinese experience. IsmatBegmurodov, a doctor of philosophy in sinology, says that China's experience in poverty reduction is the most effective way for Uzbekistan to reduce poverty. According to IsmatBegmurodov, the implementation of the concept of poverty reduction in China "on building a prosperous society until 2021" will play an important role. The unique "road map" outlined in this document can be applied in Uzbekistan as well. The expert spoke about some of the measures being taken in China to reduce poverty. In particular, every leader or party worker should take care of the people and take care of four or five families. The low-income people will be provided with seeds, seedlings, microcredits, information services, technological assistance, bonuses and other incentives instead of social benefits. The population will be taught the basics of working in a market economy and financial literacy. In addition, local courses in local animal husbandry, agriculture and other areas will be offered. Each family member must have at least one occupation. According to the expert, 100,000 yuan (about \$ 14,000) will be allocated to needy families to improve their living conditions. With the help of local authorities, low-income families can set up a repair shop, a farm or a small production workshop. The poor are provided with social guarantees - education, health care and housing. In this way, the government has established a trusting relationship with the people and has made some progress in this direction, says the doctor of philosophy. In fact, it would be much better for our population if we could introduce the above in our country. We could raise the living standards of our population to a much better level. In order to save our people from poverty, we must first of all direct our people to create their own property. In our country, the agricultural sector is also developing better than other sectors. If we could create conditions for our people to use their lands, we would be able to save our people from poverty for a while. In addition, if we could teach our people the secrets of entrepreneurship, if we could run a small business for them, they would have their own property.

"Currently, 4-5 million people in our country are poor, and their daily income does not exceed 10-13,000 soums," said ShavkatMirziyoyev. To solve this problem, we need to be able to introduce a clear road map. The income of our population cannot increase by itself, it needs investment to increase it. I liken people living in poverty to sick people, because

we can save our people from poverty, just as we can cure the sick. ShavkatMirziyoyev said, "We should give our people a hook, not a fish." In fact, there is a great deal of truth in this statement. We must convince every inhabitant of our people that they can create their own property. To do this, we must convince our people that we can completely lift them out of poverty. To do this, we need to be able to create a clear road map.
